During that time she learned to paint using acrylics, oils and watercolor.

Since then "One Stroke" painting would be a fantastic way to introduce people who "always wanted to paint but were afraid to try" to the world of art. Soon after that she began training with Dewberry and became a One Stroke Certified Instructor (OSCI). Since then Evy has introduced hundreds of students to the joy of painting using the "One Stroke" technique. The almost instant results of the "One Stroke" method yields confidence and calms the fear of failure that often deters so many students.

She furthered her studies taking classes with Zoltan Szabo, Janet Walsh, Don Andrews, Tom Jones and many of the talented teachers at the Art Academy. In addition to her pursuit of art, Evy also enjoys teaching. In 1997 Evy saw artist Donna Dewberry demonstrating her "One Stroke" technique. She quickly realized that in between giving and taking classes Evy enjoys painting scenes of the low country and Hilton Head Island, SC area where she lives.
