Joyce received a BS degree in advertising art from Rochester Institute of Technology and a MA in printmaking from Wayne State University. She has worked in graphic design studios, as a freelance graphic designer and as an art instructor in drawing, design, printmaking, acrylic, pastel and oil painting to students of all ages for 20 years in the Detroit area and 20 years on Hilton Head. She's taught workshops around the USA and done demos in France, Italy and Kenya, and has been a juror for numerous exhibitions.

"Drawing, value patterns, complimentary colors and color perspective have become the main focus of my work. Although I work in other mediums, I love the immediacy of pastel for landscape painting."

Joyce's pastels have received awards in exhibitions at the Degas Pastel Society, the Kansas Pastel Society, the Maryland Pastel Society, the Southeastern Pastel Society as a Member of Excellence, the Pastel Society of the West Coast, and as a Signature Member of the Pastel Society of America. She has received a Gold Addy for Illustration from the Savannah Art Director's Club, and is a past president of the Birmingham (Michigan) Society of Women Painters. Her highlight award for 2004 was her Best of Show at the Hilton Head Art League Annual Juried exhibition.

Recently, she has teamed with her husband to teach pastel workshops offering the student a variety of insights to the art of pastel painting.
