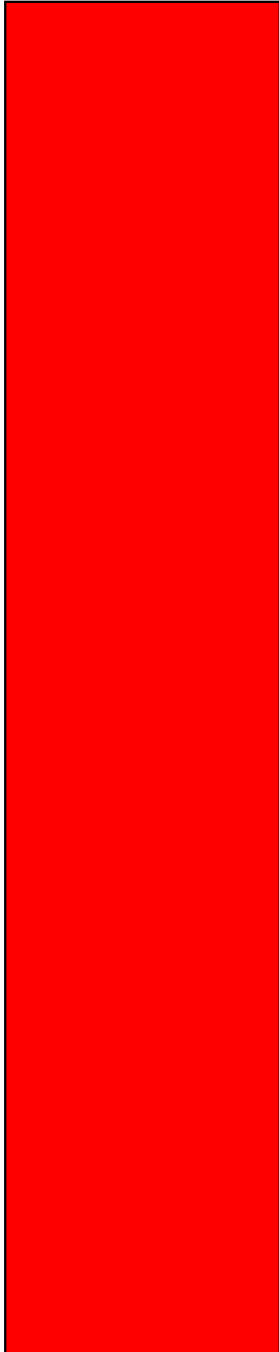

Since making Hilton Head Island her winter home in 1997, Uschi has taught landscape painting and/or portraiture at Creation Station (predecessor of the Art Academy), SHARE, the Society of Bluffton Artists, and Sun City.

Her current classes at the Academy focus on painting "en plein air"--that is, working outside on location at picturesque sites around the Island. She challenges her students to paint directly from nature rather than being content with copying from photographs in a studio. All levels of artistic experience are welcome, including beginners or those returning to painting after years of inactivity. Artists in her classes use oils, acrylics, watercolor or pastels.

Uschi's formal art education began in her native Germany. In the U.S., she has studied art at the Corcoran Institute (now College of Art and Design), Montgomery (MD) College and Skidmore College. As a continuing student of art herself, her favorite pastime when traveling is to plan trips around visits to art galleries and museums.

Uschi spends summers in a small village in France where since 1999 she has hosted painters from the Hilton Head area and elsewhere in her ten-day ART IN BURGUNDY "en plein air" excursions.
