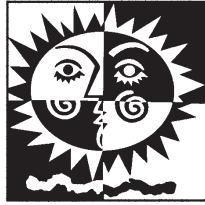

Craig Srebnik, an award-winning painter and instructor, was born in Los Angeles and raised in Portland, Oregon. After college, he moved to New York City, where he began his art studies.

“I organized a self-study program influenced by European studios and academies of past centuries. This included anatomy, life drawing, studies of the Old Masters, art history, museum and gallery visits, and other research in the United State and Europe.”

Craig moved to Paris after New York, where he returns to paint and teach while based in Boston. His work has been described as “a painterly, Classical Naturalism”—sinuous, romantic figures reminiscent of the timeless beauty of the Classical and Baroque Masters, combined with the light, atmosphere and expressive brushwork of contemporary Impressionism.

Craig Srebnik’s artwork has earned twenty-four national awards, including two Awards of Excellence from the Oil Painters of America and the President’s Award from the American Impressionist Society. He has been featured in numerous magazines, including *American Art Collector*, *American Artist* and *Art World News*. He is currently working on a series of books based upon his experiences as artist and teacher. He conducts workshops and lectures in the U.S. and abroad at art schools, colleges, museums, galleries and cultural centers.

We are indeed proud to welcome Craig Srebnik as this year’s juror and feel certain that his talent and experience will produce an outstanding exhibition.
